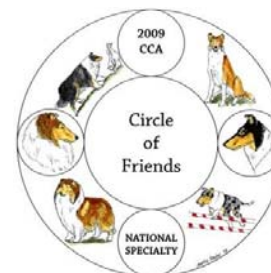

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure any dog entered in the trial. All height divisions will be offered in both the standard classes and the jumpers with weaves classes.

OBSTACLES: All obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

ENTRY FEE: \$35.00 for the first entry per dog per day; \$20.00 for the second entry of the same dog per day, and \$10.00 for the third entry. Entry fees include AKC recording fee of \$3 per dog, per day for the first entry and \$3.00 for each additional entry.

OPENING DATE: Wednesday, February 18, 2009 at 10 a.m. at 1 West Street, Belchertown, MA 01007. Entries received prior to the opening date cannot be accepted.

CLOSING DATE: Saturday, March 21, 2009 at 6 p.m., after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules and in Chapter 1, Section 13 of the AKC Agility Trial Rules and Regulations.

MOVEUPS & CANCELLATIONS: In order for move-ups and cancellations sent via email to be valid, exhibitors must receive an acknowledgement from the trial secretary. *If you do not receive an acknowledgment, assume that your request has not been received.* No refunds or changes will be made without the trial secretary's acknowledgement.

REFUNDS: All refund requests received prior to the close of entries will be charged a \$5.00 per day processing fee. After the close of entries, only refund requests for bitches in season can be accepted. Those requests must include a veterinarian's note and be received within five days of the trial. Refunds are subject to all non-refundable fees incurred by the club including, but not limited to, secretarial fees and AKC fees.

SITE INFORMATION

This trial will be held indoors in an equestrian center, with one ring in the main arena and one ring in the warm-up arena. Neither arena is heated. The ring in the main arena measures 80' x 100' and the ring in the warm up arena measures 70' x 110'. The footing is an equine footing called Euro-Felt which is a mixture of washed sand and felt. Food will be available on the premises.

There will be some parking available near the arena and plenty of parking available in a large parking lot a short walk away from the arena. There is no overnight RV parking. Please be respectful to parking attendants and do not under any circumstances park near the horse stables. Also, please be sure to have your dogs leashed AT ALL TIMES except when in the ring or in a designated warm-up area. Do NOT walk your dogs anywhere near the horse stables or paddocks or allow them to interact with any of the horses. You must pickup after your dogs, even in the nearby woods and fields.

TRIAL REGULATIONS NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

THE SAFETY of dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

THE TRIAL will be open from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. A charge of \$25.00 will be made for each returned check.

TELEPHONE, FAX, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES cannot be accepted.

NO HAND-DELIVERED ENTRIES will be accepted within the first 24 hours.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS OR PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**. **ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED, WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE. Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS—Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms; no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after trial has closed.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

DOGS PRESENT will not be permitted to roam. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior, may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees will be made. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crate at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. The site will be monitored and offenders will be asked to leave. In such cases, no refunds will be made. Dogs must use the designated exercise area.

TRIAL COMMITTEE will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

BITCHES IN SEASON shall not be eligible to participate. There will be a refund of entries for bitches coming in season after the trial has closed. Refund requests along with a veterinarian's note must be received by the trial secretary within five days of the event. Refunds are subject to all non-refundable fees incurred by the club.

DOGS PARTICIPATING must be 15 months of age or older and must be registered with the American Kennel Club, have an AKC Limited Registration, ILP, PAL, or be FSS breeds eligible to compete. Dogs must be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRY ACCEPTANCE will be made when entries are processed for those exhibitors that provide an email address. Confirmation notices including the judging schedule will be sent to all exhibitors no less than seven days prior to the event.

Directions to the Trial

From Points South (CT area): Take 91 North to exit 16 (Route 202/Holyoke-South Hadley). Turn right and ** proceed on Route 202 North through Holyoke and across the Connecticut River. Continue on Route 202 and take second exit, marked "South Hadley Center - Amherst" to Route 116 North. Continue for approximately two miles. *** At the blinking light, turn right onto Morgan St. Turn left onto Park St. The Equestrian Center is on the right.

From Points North (VT area): Take 91 South to exit 17 (Route 141/Holyoke-South Hadley). Proceed East on Route 141 until it intersects with Route 202. Turn left onto Route 202 North and follow from ** above.

From the Mass Pike - Exit 5 or the Super 8 Motor Lodge: Take Exit 5 (Chicopee). After toll booths, turn left at traffic light onto Route 33 North. Proceed for approximately 4.5 miles to Route 116. Turn right onto Route 116 and drive one mile north to the college. Follow from *** above.

From the Mass Pike - Exit 6 or the Motel 6: Take Exit 6 (Springfield). After toll booths, turn right onto Burnett Rd. Go 2.6 miles and take a left at the light onto West St (Mobil Station on the corner). (After about 3 miles, West St becomes East St; after an additional 2 miles, it becomes Pleasant St) At the intersection of Rt. 202 and Pleasant St, proceed straight through the light. Go 1.3 miles and turn right at the blinking light onto Park St. The Equestrian Center is on the right.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all *Regular* titling classes and the *FAST* titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division.

Dogs entered in the *Preferred* classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. The Judge's measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
